Roles*

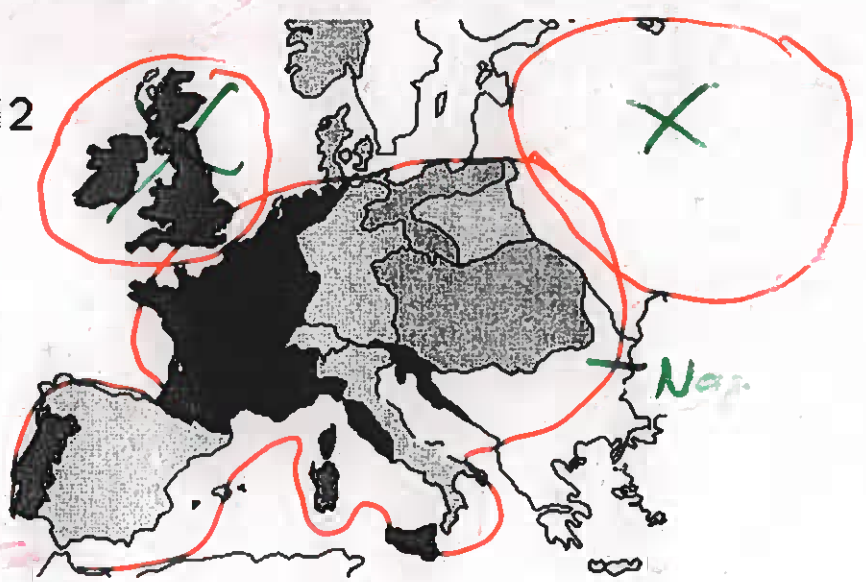
- Was a general in the French Revolution
- Became the ruler of France as the First Consul of the French Republic after overthrowing the Directory.
- Then became Emperor of the French in 1804, crowning himself. Think of why this would make monarchies in Europe sigh in relief.

*Napoleon's
Career*

- Napoleon is considered to have been a military genius, and is known for commanding many successful campaigns, together with some spectacular failures, particularly in Russia.
- Over the course of little more than a decade, he acquired control of most of continental Europe. Circle area's under his control as the photocopy is in black and white.
