GROUP	Feelings/Grievances/Resentments/Demands After WW1
Women Pg. 60 72-73	Forced out of jobs (Men Return) - with \$1 came independence, no wage - 1929 Person's Case: Women became "people" therefore can be judges (England forces us)
Veterans Pg. 48 62 64	No steady pensions, few jobs; no special medical services 1927 old age pension = \$240/year - mad at rich profiteers. Soldiers = poor and they fought in war. - Hate Prohibition (liquor rations at front)
Workers Pg. 49-50 62 64	- Demand high wages, shorter work week - Right to collective bargain - 30 000 in Winnipeg → General Strike - one big union (OBU) - form a large union to have more power
Factory Owners Pg. 51 64	- "Red Scare" - Communists; hate unions - citizen committee of 1000: Anti-Union - Scabs workers who cross picket lines - Make workers sign contract → won't join union
Aboriginals Pg. 69 74-75	- not considered people: traditions = banned - Residential Schools → Assimilation - can't vote [fought in war]
Immigrants/ Blacks Pg. 76	- treated poorly; suspected communist if from Eastern Europe - low wages - 1922 - limit Japanese immigration to 150/year - 1923 → exclude Chinese from immigration - Blacks = segregated - 1920 Edmonton Council Refuses to ban from Parks/Pool
